


## The Wildlife Society's Out in The Field (OiTF) TWS Conference Grant Application

**Application Deadline:** 

Sept 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022



This grant program is funded through generous donations provided to The Wildlife Society's Out in The Field Initiative primarily by multiple TWS organization units. The objective of this year's program is to provide up to two travel grants for \$500 each and a \$250 travel grant (provided by the TWS Biological Diversity Working Group) to **LGBTQ+ members of TWS** (students and professionals) to assist them in offsetting the cost of attending the 2022 TWS Annual Conference. Preference for funding will be given to applicants who have a role in the conference, but this is not a requirement to be considered for the grant. This grant is only to be used to support attendance at the TWS Annual Conference. Recipient must be a member in good standing of the TWS at the time of application, identify as LGBTQ+, and the funds will be provided to the recipient at conclusion of conference, once attendance at the conference has been certified by the TWS.

The recipient will be notified by September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The grant recipient is expected to use the grant for attending the TWS Conference in the year the grant is awarded. If not used, grant funds will be voided.

To collect the grant, the recipient needs to send TWS IDEA Working Group Treasurer a request for the awarded funds and include confirmation of attendance reimbursement within 14 calendar days after the TWS conference.
